Man Taken into Custody after Damaging Multiple Businesses with a Knife

On Friday, April 11th, at approximately 2:01 pm, the Village of Mamaroneck Police Department received a 911 call about a male suspect damaging a wall with a knife at a local business on the 100 block of Mamaroneck Avenue. The suspect immediately fled the scene. Officers responded to the scene, interviewed the business owner, who declined prosecution.

Moments later, a second 911 call was received about a male damaging a seat with a knife aboard a Beeline bus on 500 block of Halstead Avenue. Officers responded to the scene, interviewed the caller, who stated the male suspect followed her when she got off the bus, but he then fled the scene prior to their arrival.

A third 911 call was received about a male damaging a wall with a knife at a local business on the 200 block of Mamaroneck Ave. Officers responded to the scene, interviewed the business owner, who declined prosecution. Officers and detectives conducted a canvass of the area and located the male suspect responsible for all three incidents, on the 600 block of Halstead Avenue. The suspect was identified as Jeremie Preston, a 35-year-old homeless male; he was placed under arrest under Mental Hygiene Law 9.45, due to his erratic and violent behavior. A knife was recovered at the scene. The suspect also had an active warrant from the MTA Police Department for Criminal Mischief. He was processed, issued an appearance ticket, and has a future court date. He was immediately transported to White Plains Hospital for a mental evaluation.
